RULES OF THE COMPETITION

Once again our main sponsor for the day will be JOBS @ PERTEMPS.

Rules of the Competition which has been run for in excess of 100 years are:

1. The competition shall be open to all recognised golf clubs in the Counties of Worcestershire, Warwickshire and Staffordshire.
2. The competition shall be scratch stroke play over thirty six holes, the competitor returning the lowest score shall be the winner of the Howitt Bowl on behalf of the club the golfer represents.
3. The competition shall be limited to 39 players of 6 handicap or lower, who must enter using the entry form provided.
4. In the event of the competition being over subscribed, the Committee will conduct a ballot of the higher handicap entrants.
5. Prizes will be awarded as follows:
Best gross 36 holes
Second best gross 36 holes
Third best gross 36 holes
Best nett 36 holes (Howitt Salver)
Second best nett 36 holes
6. The competition shall be held under the Rules of Golf as approved by the Roays & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and the local rules of North Warwickshire Golf Club. The decision of the Committee shall be accepted as final.
7. The competitors shall be deemed Members of the club for the day and will be entitled to the privileges of the Club that day.
8. Competitors will be notified of their starting times and partners. These times must be strictly observed. Entries must be received no later than 17th August 2007 by the Secretary of North Warwickshire Golf Club.
