

WARWICKSHIRE AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP 2007

The 90th Warwickshire Amateur Championship will be played on Tuesday 29th May 2007
at Moor Hall Golf Club, Moor Hall Drive, Sutton Coldfield, West Midlands B75 6LN

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Qualifications:

To be eligible to enter, a player must :-

- (a) be in possession of a CONGU playing handicap not exceeding 4 at the date of application.
(Note : exception may be made for players who have represented County 1st or 2nd Teams in 2006)
- (b) enter this competition using his CONGU handicap
- (c) be a Member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union.
- (d) not have represented, or played in another County's Championship, since 30th May 2006.

2. Conditions of Play:

- (a) The Championship shall be played by Stroke Play over 36 holes.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the lowest Gross score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie for first place after 36 holes, the Championship shall be decided on the day, over 3 holes as specified by the Committee, and if still tied, by a sudden death play-off over the same holes.
- (c) Other ties will be decided on the score for the second round or, if necessary, on the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes.
- (d) Players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round.

3. Prizes:

- (a) The Winner will hold The Carl Bretherton Vase for one year, and will receive a Salver and Voucher. He will also qualify for, and be expected to compete in, the County Champions Tournament to be held at Woodhall Spa on Sunday 23rd September 2007.
- (b) The Runner-up will receive a Silver medal and Voucher.
- (c) 3rd Place will receive a Bronze medal and Voucher, and there will also be Vouchers for 4th, 5th and 6th Best Gross.
- (d) The Warwickshire Union Team Challenge Shield and Vouchers will be awarded to the club team returning the BEST TWO OUT OF THREE GROSS aggregate scores. The Winners qualify for, and will be expected to compete in, the English Champion Club Tournament to be played at Hesketh Golf Club on 14th and 15th September 2007.
- (e) No competitor may receive more than one prize.
- (f) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.
- (g) The 8 players returning the best Gross scores over 36 holes will qualify to play in the Warwickshire Matchplay Championship for the T.P.Cooke Challenge Cup to be played at Moor Hall Golf Club on 8th and 10th June 2007.
- (h) The 25 players returning the best Gross scores over 36 holes will qualify to play in the Warwickshire Open Championship to be played at Maxstoke Park Golf Club on Monday 3rd September 2007.

4. Entry Applications:

- (a) It is a strict condition of entry that where a competitor will be under the age of 18 years on the date of the competition, a Parental Consent Form is completed and returned with the Entry Form.
- (b) Applications must only be made on the Entry Form, all cheques should be made payable to Warwickshire Union of Golf Clubs (or WUGC) and must be sent with your completed Entry Application Form and – if appropriate - a Parental Consent Form, together with a 1st class S.A.E. to :

5. After play all competitors are required to change from their on course attire – preferably into jackets and ties.
6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by Local Rules.
7. A practice round may be arranged, subject to availability as determined by Moor Hall Golf Club. Contact should initially be made through the Club Manager / Secretary on 0121 308 6130.
8. Any questions arising as to Qualification, Rules of Golf or any other points will be considered by the Executive Committee of the WUGC whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
