

WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY TRIALS 2007

The Warwickshire County Trials will be played on Sunday 15th April 2007
at Walmley Golf Club, Brooks Road, Wylde Green, Sutton Coldfield, Warwickshire B72 1HR

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Qualifications:

To be eligible to enter, a player must :-

- (a) be in possession of a playing handicap not exceeding 3 at the date of entry.
(Note : exception may be made for players who have represented County 1st or 2nd Teams in 2006)
- (b) be a Member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union.
- (c) not have represented, or played in another County's Championship, since 16th April 2006.

2. Conditions of Play:

- (a) The Trial shall be played as an 18 hole Gross Stableford.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the highest Gross points over 18 holes.
In the event of a tie for first place after 18 holes, the Winner will be decided on the highest Gross points for the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes.
- (c) Players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round.

3. Prizes:

- (a) Vouchers will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Best Gross points scored.
- (b) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.

4. Entry Applications:

- (a) It is a strict condition of entry that where a competitor will be under the age of 18 years on the date of the competition, a Parental Consent Form is completed and returned with the Entry Form.
- (b) Applications must only be made on the Entry Form, all cheques should be made payable to Warwickshire Union of Golf Clubs (or WUGC) and must be sent with your completed Entry Application Form and – where appropriate - a Parental Consent Form, together with a 1st class S.A.E. to :

5. After play all competitors are required to change from their on course attire – preferably into jackets and ties.
6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by Local Rules.
7. Any questions arising as to qualifications, Rules of Golf or any other points will be considered by the Executive Committee of the WUGC whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
