

WARWICKSHIRE BOYS UNDER 16's CHAMPIONSHIP 2007

The 2nd Warwickshire Boys Under 16's Championship will be played on Monday 20th August 2007
at Coventry Hearsall Golf Club, Beechwood Avenue, Earlsdon, Coventry CV5 6DF

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Qualifications:

To be eligible to enter, a player must :-

- (a) be under the age of 16 years at 00:00 hours on 1st January 2007
- (b) be in possession of a playing handicap not exceeding 24
- (c) have been born in Warwickshire or be a Junior Member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union or be the son of a Full Member of an affiliated Warwickshire Golf Club - provided that they have not represented, or played in another County's Junior or Boys Championship, since 21st August 2006.

2. Conditions of Play:

- (a) The Championship shall be played by Stroke Play over 36 holes.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 36 holes. . In the event of a tie after 36 holes, the Winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off over holes as specified by the Committee.
- (c) Other ties will be decided on the score for the second round or, if necessary, on the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes.
- (d) No caddies will be allowed, and players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round.

3. Prizes:

- (a) The Winner will hold The Warwickshire Past Captains Trophy for one year, and will receive a Silver medal and Voucher. He will also qualify for, and be expected to compete in, the Midland Junior Champions Tournament to be held at Greetham Valley Golf Club on 15th and 16th September 2007.
- (b) The Runner-up will receive a Bronze medal and Voucher.
- (c) There will also be Vouchers for 3rd, 4th and 5th Best Gross scores, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Best Nett scores, over 36 holes.
- (d) Vouchers will also be awarded for Best Gross and Best Ntet in each of the morning and afternoon rounds.
- (e) No competitor may receive more than one prize.
- (f) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.

4. Entry Applications:

- (a) It is a strict condition of entry that where a competitor will be under the age of 18 years on the date of the competition, a Parental Consent Form is completed and returned with the Entry Form.
- (b) Applications must only be made on the Entry Form, all cheques should be made payable to Warwickshire Union of Golf Clubs (or WUGC) and must be sent with your completed Entry Application Form and a Parental Consent Form, together with a 1st class S.A.E. to :

- 5. After play all competitors are required to change from their on course attire into jackets and ties.
- 6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by Local Rules.
- 7. Any questions arising as to qualifications, Rules of Golf or any other points will be considered by the Executive Committee of the WUGC whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
